Deceased Name: Dwight E. Haugen

A Mass of Christian burial will be at noon Saturday, Nov. 20, 1999, in St. Thomas More Catholic Church for Dwight E. Haugen, who died Nov. 14 in Phoenix, Ariz., after heart surgery at age 73.

Mr. Haugen was born Sept. 17, 1926, in Portland. He graduated from Franklin High School. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Navy. After the war, he graduated from Oregon State College and in 1952 received a master's degree from Harvard Business School. He was president and owner of Wedgewood Homes in Beaverton from the early 1960s until retiring in the late 1970s. After retiring, he lived in Sun Valley, Idaho; Sunriver; and Phoenix. He served as Oregon's director of vocational rehabilitation under Gov. Mark Hatfield and on the Board of Trustees of Lewis & Clark College. He was a past president of the Harvard Business Club in Portland. He was a member of the church. In 1976, he married Kazimiera Zak.

Survivors include his wife; daughters, Kathleen Hubener of Sandpoint, Idaho, Karen of Pullman, Wash., and Nancy Kayani of Portland; stepdaughter, Nusia Namba of West Linn; stepsons, Janusz Rozycki of Wilsonville and Dr. Marek Rozycki of Modesto, Calif.; sister, Elizabeth Yates of Seattle; and 11 grandchildren.

Private interment will be in Skyline Memorial Gardens. Arrangements are by Skyline Funeral Home.
